- 2. When and where will it take place? Entry tests will be given at the discretion of the King of Arms/Lady of Honour at any time during the event.
- 3. Invitational tournament: No
- Is selection process objective? Yes.
- What are parameters? Selection will be determined by the competitor applying to compete. There are a limited number of competitor slots and the final roster will be determined by the order in which the completed waiver packets are returned.
